AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- Consolidated Statutes, further providing for the offense of
- 3 loitering and prowling at night.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 5506 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 5506. Loitering and prowling [at night time].
- 9 [Whoever] (a) Offense defined. -- A person who [at night time]
- 10 maliciously loiters or maliciously prowls around a dwelling
- 11 house or any other place used wholly or in part for living or
- 12 dwelling purposes, belonging to or occupied by another, [is
- 13 guilty of a misdemeanor of the third degree.] commits an
- 14 <u>offense.</u>
- 15 (b) Grading. -- An offense under subsection (a) constitutes a:
- 16 (1) Misdemeanor of the third degree when the offense is

- 1 <u>a first offense.</u>
- 2 (2) Misdemeanor of the second degree when the offense is
- 3 a second offense.
- 4 (3) Misdemeanor of the first degree when the offense is
- 5 a third offense.
- 6 (4) Felony of the third degree when the offense is a
- 7 <u>fourth or subsequent offense.</u>
- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
