AN ACT

- Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for accidents involving death or personal injury.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 3742(b) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended and the section is amended by
- 8 adding a subsection to read:
- 9 § 3742. Accidents involving death or personal injury.
- 10 * * *
- 11 (b) Penalties.--
- 12 (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section, any
- 13 person violating this section commits a misdemeanor of the
- first degree, and the sentencing court shall order the person

to pay a fine of not less than \$300.

(2) If the victim suffers serious bodily injury, any person violating subsection (a) commits a felony of the third degree, and the sentencing court shall order the person to serve a minimum term of imprisonment of not less than 90 days and a mandatory minimum fine of \$1,000, notwithstanding any other provision of law. An additional fine and term of imprisonment under this paragraph shall be imposed for each victim whose serious bodily injury is the result of the violation of subsection (a).

- (3) If the victim dies, any person violating subsection

 (a) commits a felony of the [third] second degree, and the sentencing court shall order the person to serve a minimum term of imprisonment of not less than one year and a mandatory minimum fine of \$2,500, notwithstanding any other provision of law. An additional fine and term of imprisonment under this paragraph shall be imposed for each victim whose death is the result of the violation of subsection (a).

 (b.1) Enhanced penalties.—
- (1) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, any person violating this section concurrently with a violation of section 3802 (relating to driving under influence of alcohol or controlled substance) and who is convicted of violating section 3802 commits a felony of the third degree.
 - (2) If the victim suffers serious bodily injury, any person violating subsection (a) concurrently with a violation of section 3802 and who is convicted of violating section

 3802 commits a felony of the second degree, and the sentencing court shall order the person to serve a minimum term of imprisonment of not less than one year and a

- 1 <u>mandatory fine of \$2,500, notwithstanding any other provision</u>
- 2 <u>of law. An additional fine and term of imprisonment under</u>
- 3 this paragraph shall be imposed for each victim whose serious
- 4 <u>bodily injury is the result of the violation of subsection</u>
- 5 <u>(a)</u>.
- 6 (3) If the victim dies, any person violating subsection
- 7 (a) concurrently with a violation of section 3802 and who is
- 8 <u>convicted of violating section 3802 commits a felony of the</u>
- 9 <u>second degree</u>, and the sentencing court shall order the
- 10 person to serve a minimum term of imprisonment of not less
- than three years and a mandatory fine of \$5,000,
- 12 notwithstanding any other provision of law. An additional
- fine and term of imprisonment under this paragraph shall be
- imposed for each victim whose death is the result of the
- 15 violation of subsection (a).
