1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11 12 13 14 15 16 17 18 19 20 21	Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the Executive Department thereof and the administrative departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative officers, and of the several administrative departments, boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the number and compensation of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and commissions shall be determined," in powers and duties in general, prohibiting agencies from awarding legislative initiative grants.

- 1 Prohibited. -- No executive agency, independent agency or State-
- 2 <u>affiliated entity as those terms are defined in 62 Pa.C.S. §</u>
- 3 103 (relating to definitions), may award a legislative initiative
- 4 grant or other grant that is approved, in whole or in part, on
- 5 the basis of a recommendation made by or on behalf of a member
- 6 of the General Assembly.
- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
