| 9 | (a) General ruleUpon submission by a vehicle owner of |
| 10 | information satisfactory to the department that a motorcycle or |
| 11 | motor vehicle is an antique motorcycle or motor vehicle or |
| 12 | classic motorcycle or motor vehicle or collectible motorcycle or |
| 13 | motor vehicle, accompanied by the appropriate fee, the |
| 14 | department may issue special plates for the motorcycle or |
| 15 | vehicle. The special plate for antique motor vehicles, except |
| 16 | antique motorcycles, shall bear the designation "antique |

vehicle." The applicant shall provide photographic proof in a 1 manner specified by the department to demonstrate the condition 2 3 of the motor vehicle. No annual registration fee may be charged for antique, collectible or classic motorcycles or motor 4 vehicles. A holder of the special plates may obtain replacement 5 plates bearing the designation "antique vehicle" upon payment of 6 the appropriate fee. The applicant may provide for the 7 department's approval vintage Pennsylvania plates from the year 8 9 listed on the vehicle's certificate of title for antique or 10 classic vehicles. The department may charge an additional fee of \$20 to verify and authorize use of the vintage plates in lieu of 11 department-issued plates. 12 * * * 13
