AN ACT

Amending the act of July 4, 2008 (P.L. , No.38A), entitled "An 1 act to provide from the General Fund for the expenses of the 2 3 Executive, Legislative and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth, the public debt and the public schools for the 4 fiscal year July 1, 2008, to June 30, 2009, for certain 5 institutions and organizations, and for the payment of bills 6 7 incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008; to provide appropriations from the 8 9 State Lottery Fund, the Energy Conservation and Assistance Fund, the Hazardous Material Response Fund, The State Stores 10 Fund, the Milk Marketing Fund, the Home Investment Trust 11 Fund, the Emergency Medical Services Operating Fund, the 12 Tuition Payment Fund, the Banking Department Fund, the 13 Firearm Records Check Fund, the Ben Franklin Technology 14 Development Authority Fund and the Tobacco Settlement Fund to 15 16 the Executive Department; to provide appropriations from the Judicial Computer System Augmentation Account to the Judicial 17 18 Department for the fiscal year July 1, 2008, to June 30, 2009; to provide appropriations from the Motor License Fund 19 for the fiscal year July 1, 2008, to June 30, 2009, for the proper operation of the several departments of the 20 21 22 Commonwealth and the Pennsylvania State Police authorized to 23 spend Motor License Fund moneys; to provide for the appropriation of Federal funds to the Executive Department of 24 the Commonwealth and for the payment of bills remaining 25 26 unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008; 27 to provide for the additional appropriation of Federal and State funds from the General Fund for the Executive, 28 29 Legislative and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth for the fiscal year July 1, 2007, to June 30, 2008, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close 30 31 32 of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2007," adding a new abbreviation; increasing and decreasing certain State 33 appropriations and certain Federal appropriations; and adding 34 new Federal appropriations. 35
