AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," providing for workers' compensation safety committees.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a section to read:

Section 615. Workers' Compensation Safety Committee.--(a) Each school district shall have and maintain a certified safety committee by December 31, 2010, for the purposes of section $1002(\mathrm{~b})$ of the act of June 2, 1915 (P.L.736, No. 338) , known as the "Workers' Compensation Act." The Department of Labor and Industry shall annually provide the Department of Education with the list of school districts who have a certified safety committee. In the case of a school district that does not comply

1 with this section, the Department of Education shall annually
2 deduct from any allocation from the Commonwealth to which the
3 school district is entitled the amount of the discount the
4 school district would otherwise receive under section $1002(\mathrm{~b})$ of
5 the "Workers' Compensation Act."
6 (b) This section shall not apply to a school district that
7 would not qualify for the discount under section $1002(b)$ of the
8 "Workers' Compensation Act" by virtue of the establishment of a
9 certified safety committee.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2009.
