- 10 (c) Processing fee in lieu of registration fee.--No
- 11 registration fee shall be charged for vehicles registered by any
- 12 of the following but the department shall charge a fee of \$10 to
- 13 cover the costs of processing for issuing or renewing the
- 14 registration:

- 16 (16) Any person who is retired and receiving social

- 1 security or other pension and whose total annual income does
- 2 not exceed \$19,200. Unless the retired person is physically
- 3 or mentally incapable of driving the vehicle, the retired
- 4 person shall be the principal driver of the vehicle but may
- from time to time authorize another person to drive the
- 6 vehicle in his or her stead. For purposes of this paragraph,
- 7 <u>the term "income" shall not include a stipend received from</u>
- 8 <u>the Federal Government under the American Recovery and</u>
- 9 Reinvestment Act of 2009 (Public Law 111-5, 123 Stat. 115).
