AN ACT

1 Designating the reconstructed Gay Street Bridge on State Route  
2 113, which crosses French Creek in the Borough of  
3 Phoenixville, Chester County, as the Veterans Memorial Gay  
4 Street Bridge.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Veterans Memorial Gay Street Bridge.

8 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as  
9 follows:

10 (1) On August 11, 2009, Phoenixville Borough Council  
11 adopted a resolution recommending that the Gay Street Bridge  
12 be renamed the Veterans Memorial Gay Street Bridge.

13 (2) The bridge designation honors the commitment,  
14 service and sacrifice of this country's veterans and will  
15 serve as a tangible reminder of the courage and patriotism of  
16 the veterans who served this Commonwealth and this nation.

17 (b) Designation.--The Gay Street Bridge on State Route 113,  
18 which crosses French Creek in the Borough of Phoenixville,  
19 Chester County, is hereby designated as the Veterans Memorial

1 Gay Street Bridge.

2 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and  
3 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to  
4 traffic in both directions.

5 Section 2. Effective date.

6 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
