7	Section 1. Section 4906(c) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
8	Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a paragraph to read:

6	(i) knowingly gives false information to law

2	offense within their concern knowing that it did not

4	(iii) pretends to furnish such authorities with

7	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
