10	(b) Disabled veterans
11	(1) Any resident disabled veteran of any war or armed
12	conflict whose physical disability consists of the loss of
13	one or more limbs, or the loss of the use of one or more
14	limbs, or whose physical disability is considered total and
15	who meets all other qualifications of this title and is
16	otherwise mentally and physically fit, shall be issued [a

regular hunting or furtaking license] <u>the following licenses</u> upon application to any county treasurer, without the payment of the license cost, if that person is domiciled in this Commonwealth[.]:

5	<u>(i) Regular hunting.</u>
6	<u>(ii) Regular furtaking.</u>
7	(iii) Archery.
8	(iv) Muzzleloader.

10	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
