AN ACT

Amending Title 68 (Real and Personal Property) of the 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, prohibiting deed restrictions pertaining to environmental improvements to 3 4 property. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Title 68 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: § 7104. Prohibition of deed restrictions pertaining to 10 environmental property improvements. 11 (a) General rule. -- No EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B), 12 NO deed restrictions, covenants or similar binding agreements running with the land shall prohibit or have the effect of 13 14 prohibiting a solar energy system or other energy device based 15 on a renewable resource from being installed on a building 16 erected on a lot or parcel covered by the deed restrictions,

covenants or binding agreements. A property owner may not be

- 1 denied permission to install a solar energy system or other
- 2 <u>energy device based on a renewable resource by any entity</u>
- 3 granted the power or right in any deed restriction, covenant or
- 4 <u>similar binding agreement to approve, forbid, control or direct</u>
- 5 alteration of property with respect to residential dwellings or
- 6 <u>real property.</u>
- 7 (B) ASSOCIATIONS.--THE GOVERNING DOCUMENTS OF AN ASSOCIATION
- 8 CREATED PURSUANT TO SUBPART B (RELATING TO CONDOMINIUMS) OR
- 9 <u>SUBPART D (RELATING TO PLANNED COMMUNITIES) MAY PROVIDE</u>
- 10 REASONABLE REGULATION OF SOLAR PANELS AND OTHER RENEWABLE
- 11 RESOURCE ENERGY DEVICES FOR THE FOLLOWING PURPOSES:
- 12 (1) TO REQUIRE THAT THE SOLAR PANEL OR OTHER RENEWABLE
- 13 <u>RESOURCE ENERGY DEVICE MEETS APPLICABLE HEALTH AND SAFETY</u>
- 14 <u>STANDARDS AND REQUIREMENTS IMPOSED BY STATE AND LOCAL</u>
- 15 PERMITTING AUTHORITIES.
- 16 (2) IF USED TO HEAT WATER, THE DEVICE IS CERTIFIED BY
- 17 THE SOLAR RATING AND CERTIFICATION CORPORATION OR OTHER
- 18 NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED CERTIFICATION AGENCY. CERTIFICATION
- 19 MUST BE FOR THE DEVICE ITSELF AND FOR THE METHOD OF
- 20 INSTALLATION.
- 21 (3) IF USED TO PRODUCE ELECTRICITY, THE DEVICE MEETS ALL
- 22 APPLICABLE SAFETY AND PERFORMANCE STANDARDS ESTABLISHED BY
- THE NATIONAL ELECTRIC CODE, THE INSTITUTE OF ELECTRICAL AND
- 24 ELECTRONICS ENGINEERS, ACCREDITED TESTING LABORATORIES, SUCH
- 25 <u>AS UNDERWRITERS LABORATORIES, AND APPLICABLE RULES OF</u>
- 26 AGENCIES OF THE COMMONWEALTH REGARDING SAFETY AND
- 27 RELIABILITY.
- 28 (4) TO PROHIBIT THE VISIBILITY OF ANY PART OF A ROOF-
- 29 <u>MOUNTED DEVICE ABOVE THE ROOF LINE.</u>
- 30 (5) TO REQUIRE THAT A SOLAR ENERGY PANEL FRAME, A

1 SUPPORT BRACKET OR ANY VISIBLE PIPING OR WIRING TO BE PAINTED 2 TO COORDINATE WITH THE ROOFING MATERIAL. 3 (6) TO REQUIRE UNIT OWNERS INSTALLING SOLAR ENERGY 4 PANELS AND OTHER RENEWABLE RESOURCE ENERGY DEVICES TO 5 INDEMNIFY OR REIMBURSE THE ASSOCIATION OR ITS MEMBERS FOR 6 LOSS OR DAMAGE CAUSED BY THE INSTALLATION, MAINTENANCE OR USE 7 OF THE DEVICE. 8 (7) TO INCLUDE OTHER REASONABLE RULES REGARDING THE 9 PLACEMENT OF SOLAR ENERGY PANELS AND OTHER RENEWABLE RESOURCE ENERGY DEVICES SO AS TO MAINTAIN THE AESTHETIC QUALITIES OF 10 THE BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS OF THE COMMUNITY. 11 (b) Exceptions. This (C) EXCEPTION. -- THIS section shall 12 13 not apply to freestanding solar energy systems that are placed

on a parcel of land within deeded property.

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.

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
