AN ACT

1 Amending Title 3 (Agriculture) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, in domestic animals, further providing for
3 application.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 2380.3 of Title 3 of the Pennsylvania
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 2380.3. Application.

9 (a) Form.--An application for licensure, including license
10 renewal, must be made on a form prescribed by the department.

11 (b) Fee.--An application for a license or for renewal of a
12 license shall be accompanied by a fee of ~~\$75~~ \$150. License fees ←
13 collected under this section shall be deposited in the Cervidae
14 Livestock Operation Account, which is established as a
15 restricted account in the State Treasury. Moneys in the Cervidae
16 Livestock Operation Account are appropriated on a continuing
17 basis to the department for the purpose of administering this

1 chapter. All earnings received from investment or deposit of the
2 moneys in the Cervidae Livestock Operation Account shall be paid
3 into the account for the purpose authorized by this subsection.
4 Any unexpended moneys and any interest earned on the money in
5 the Cervidae Livestock Operation Account may not be transferred
6 or revert to the General Fund, but shall remain in the account
7 to be used by the department for the purpose specified in this
8 subsection.

9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
