(1) The deed of eonveyance shall contain the following restrictive covenant: "Under and subject to a eondition that the land eonveyed herein shall be used solely for agricultural purposes in the furtherance of the Grantee's mission of education related to agricultural seiences. Should the Grantee attempt to convey the property, or any portion thereof, (othex than exehanges for pareels known as interiors or indentures which may be conveyed among the parties to solidify contiguous management parcels and promote overall management goals and objectives of the parties involved), or utilize it for any other purpose, the property shall immediately revert to the Grantor."
(2) The eonveyance shall be made under and subject to arestrictive eovenant that the Grantee shall eonvey and reeord a perpetual conservation easement to the Clearwater Conservancy and the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources as eo holders as that term is defined in the act of June 22, 2001 (P.I. 390, No.29), known as the conservation and Preservation Fasements Aet, their suceessors and assigns, that the Grantee shall negotiate with the Clearwater Conservancy and the Department of Conservation and Natural Resourees and the perpetual conservation easement shall be in furtherance of the following conservation goals: to preserve the property's unique natural resources, including the biological resources, native species and their supporting habitats whieh include native species that are uneommon in this Commonwealth; and to preserve the integrity of Spring

Greek, eurrently designated as a high quality eold water fishery which requires the protection of the property's groundwater recharge value and its springs, wetlands and floodplains, eonsistent with and guided by the Mastex site Development Plan and Environmental Assessment, aceepted by the Department of Conservation and Natural Resourees and adopted by Benner Township. The covenant shall provide that in the event the perpetual conservation easement is not so eonveyed and reeorded within two years of the effective date of the eonveyance under subsection (a), then the property shall immediately revert to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. (e) Gaming facility restrietion. Any eonveyance authorized under this section shall be made under and subject to the eondition, which shall be contained in the deed of conveyance, that no portion of the property conveyed shall be used as a licensed facility, as defined in 4 Pa.C.S \& 1103 (relating todefinitions), or any other similar type of facility authorized under state law. The condition shall be a covenant running with the land and shall be binding upon the Grantee, its suecessors and assigns. Should the Grantee, its suceessors or assigns, permit any portion of the property authorized to be eonveyed in this section to be used in violation of this subsection, the title shall immediately revert to and revest in the Grantor.
