INTRODUCED BY D. EVANS, MARCH 5, 2010

REFERRED TO COMMITTEE ON APPROPRIATIONS, MARCH 5, 2010

A SUPPLEMENT

1 To the act of April 1, 1863 (P.L.213, No.227), entitled "An act
2 to accept the grant of Public Lands, by the United States, to
3 the several states, for the endowment of Agricultural
4 Colleges," making appropriations for carrying the same into
5 effect; and providing for a basis for payments of such
6 appropriations, for a method of accounting for the funds
7 appropriated and for certain fiscal information disclosure.

8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
9 hereby enacts as follows:

10 Section 1. (a) In order to carry into effect the act of
11 Congress, approved July 2, 1862, granting public land to the
12 several states for educational purposes, and subsequent acts of
13 Congress related thereto, and the act of the General Assembly of
14 Pennsylvania accepting the provisions and conditions of said
15 acts of Congress and pledging the faith of the State to carry
16 the same into effect, the following sums, or as much thereof as
17 may be necessary, are hereby appropriated to the Trustees of The
18 Pennsylvania State University for the fiscal year July 1, 2010,
19 to June 30, 2011, for the purposes and in the amounts as shown:

20 For general support.

21 State appropriation.....\$304,449,000

1 For Pennsylvania College of Technology.

2 State appropriation.....\$13,623,000

3 (b) The following Federal amounts are hereby appropriated to
4 the Trustees of The Pennsylvania State University in order to
5 supplement the sums appropriated under subsection (a):

6 (1) "ARRA - Fiscal Stabilization - General Support."

7 Federal appropriation.....\$15,115,000

8 (2) "ARRA - Fiscal Stabilization - Pennsylvania College of
9 Technology."

10 Federal appropriation.....\$676,000

11 (c) For purposes of this section, "ARRA" means the American
12 Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (Public Law 111-5, 123
13 Stat. 115).

14 Section 2. Payments to The Pennsylvania State University on
15 account of the appropriations for all items as provided in
16 section 1 shall be made on the basis of costs during the fiscal
17 year.

18 Section 3. (a) Payments to The Pennsylvania State
19 University of the appropriations provided in section 1(a) and
20 (b) shall be made monthly during the fiscal year.

21 (b) Such monthly payments shall be made in accordance with
22 the provisions of section 2 on the basis of estimated costs. The
23 estimate of costs shall be submitted by The Pennsylvania State
24 University to the Secretary of Education, the General Assembly
25 and the State Treasurer not later than 30 days prior to the date
26 on which such payment is to be made.

27 Section 4. (a) The Pennsylvania State University shall
28 apply the moneys appropriated by this act only for such purposes
29 as are permitted in this act and shall at all times maintain
30 proper records showing the application of such moneys. Not later

1 than 120 days after June 30, 2011, The Pennsylvania State
2 University shall file, with the Secretary of Education, the
3 General Assembly and the Auditor General of the Commonwealth, a
4 statement setting forth the amounts and purposes of all
5 expenditures made from moneys appropriated by this act and other
6 university accounts during said fiscal year, as provided in
7 section 2, used as a basis for receipt of any appropriation
8 during said fiscal year.

9 (b) Such statement of expenditures and costs shall be
10 reviewed by the Auditor General of the Commonwealth, and he
11 shall have the right, in respect to the moneys appropriated by
12 this act, to audit and disallow expenditures made for purposes
13 not permitted by this act and to cause such sums to be recovered
14 and paid by The Pennsylvania State University to the State
15 Treasurer. In respect to expenditures made by the university
16 from moneys other than those appropriated by this act, the
17 Auditor General shall have the right to review only, and he
18 shall file annually with the General Assembly such information
19 concerning such expenditures as the General Assembly or any of
20 its committees may require.

21 Section 5. The Pennsylvania State University shall provide
22 full, complete and accurate information as may be required by
23 the Department of Education or the chairman or the minority
24 chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the Senate or the
25 chairman or the minority chairman of the Appropriations
26 Committee of the House of Representatives.

27 Section 6. The Pennsylvania State University shall present
28 and report its financial statements required under the
29 provisions of this act in accordance with: the generally
30 accepted accounting principles as prescribed by the National

1 Association of College and University Business Officers, the
2 American Institute of Certified Public Accountants, or their
3 successors, or by any other recognized authoritative body; the
4 "Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Budget Instructions for the State
5 System of Higher Education, State-Related Universities and Non-
6 State-Related Colleges and Universities"; and, the financial
7 reporting policies and standards promulgated by the Commonwealth
8 of Pennsylvania and by the Federal Government that apply to The
9 Pennsylvania State University.

10 Section 7. This act shall take effect July 1, 2010, or
11 immediately, whichever is later.
