AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 65 (Public Officers) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for definitions
- 3 relating to ethics standards and financial disclosure.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The definition of "executive-level State
- 7 employee" in section 1102 of Title 65 of the Pennsylvania
- 8 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 9 § 1102. Definitions.
- 10 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 11 shall have, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, the
- 12 meanings given to them in this section:
- 13 * * *
- "Executive-level State employee." The Governor, [Lieutenant
- 15 Governor, cabinet members, deputy secretaries, the Governor's
- 16 office staff, any State employee with discretionary powers which
- 17 may affect the outcome of a State agency's decision in relation
- 18 to a private corporation or business or any employee who by

- 1 virtue of his job function could influence the outcome of such a
- 2 decision.

- 4 Section 2. Upon the ratification of the amendment to the
- 5 Constitution of Pennsylvania abolishing the office of Lieutenant
- 6 Governor, the Secretary of the Commonwealth shall cause the date
- 7 of ratification to be published in the Pennsylvania Bulletin.
- 8 Section 3. This act shall take effect as follows:
- 9 (1) Section 2 of this act and this section shall take
- 10 effect immediately.
- 11 (2) Section 1 of this act shall take effect upon
- 12 publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin of the ratification
- date of the amendment to the Constitution of Pennsylvania
- that abolishes the office of Lieutenant Governor.
