- 5 Hamas, held a six-month truce that ended on December 19, 2008;

- 7 WHEREAS, The people of Israel have endured rocket attacks and
- 8 other forms of terror from Hamas; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Rocket and mortar attacks from Hamas and Palestinian
- 10 militants have attacked cities in southern Israel, such as
- 11 Beersheba and Ashdod; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The State of Israel has a right to defend itself and
- 13 its people; and
- 14 WHEREAS, The State of Israel has been a strong and steady
- 15 ally of the United States and is the strongest democratic state

- 1 in the Middle East; therefore be it
- 2 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
- 3 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania urge the Congress of the United
- 4 States to support the people and government of the State of
- 5 Israel in the Israeli-Palestinian Conflict.
