- 4 WHEREAS, At an awards ceremony in Washington, DC, on October
- 5 21, 2008, the Federal Department of Education recognized 230
- 6 schools in the nation as 2008 No Child Left Behind Blue Ribbon
- 7 Schools; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Homer-Center High School was one of these schools,
- 9 an achievement signifying the high level of academic success its
- 10 students have reached through significant progress in testing
- 11 scores and program initiatives; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Homer-Center High School was one of only 12 schools
- 13 and three high schools to make a presentation during the awards
- 14 ceremony, presenting the "Scheduling for Success" program it

- 1 initiated during the 2001-2002 school year and has used since
- 2 then with increasing success; and
- 3 WHEREAS, "Scheduling for Success" recognized the value of
- 4 good nutrition, and a free breakfast program was made available
- 5 to all students; and
- 6 WHEREAS, In addition, the homeroom system was redesigned to
- 7 create remedial mathematics and remedial reading opportunities,
- 8 with students assigned to homerooms based upon their
- 9 Pennsylvania System of School Assessment test scores; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Homer-Center High School was one of only 12 schools
- 11 in this Commonwealth to be honored this year as a Blue Ribbon
- 12 school; therefore be it
