- Communities, direct the Majority Leader of the Senate and the 10
- 11 Majority Leader of the House of Representatives to appoint a

- 16 RESOLVED, That the membership of the commission be:

 3 Economic Development, who shall serve as chairperson.
 - (2) The chairperson and minority chairperson of the Local Government Committee of the Senate or their designees.
 - (3) The chairperson and minority chairperson of the Local Government Committee of the House of Representatives or their designees.
- 9 (2) One member of the Senate appointed by the Majority
 10 Leader of the Senate.
 - (3) One member of the Senate appointed by the Minority Leader of the Senate.
 - (4) One member of the House of Representatives appointed by the Majority Leader of the House of Representatives.
 - (5) One member of the House of Representatives appointed by the Minority Leader of the House of Representatives.
 - (6) Members appointed as follows:
 - (i) A representative of the Pennsylvania Economy

 League, appointed from a list submitted by the league to

 the Speaker of the House of Representatives.
 - (ii) A representative of the Council of State

 Governments, appointed from a list submitted by the

 council to the Speaker of the House of Representatives.
 - (iii) A representative of the County Commissioners
 Association of Pennsylvania, appointed from a list
 submitted by the association to the Speaker of the House
 of Representatives.
- (iv) Two representatives of 10,000 Friends of
 Pennsylvania, one representing the organization is at
 large and one representing the organization's subsidiary

- campaign to Renew Pennsylvania, both appointed from a list submitted by the organization to the Speaker of the House of Representatives.
 - (v) A representative of the Pennsylvania State
 Association of Township Supervisors, appointed from a
 list submitted by the association to the President pro
 tempore of the Senate.
 - (vi) A representative of the Pennsylvania State

 Association of Boroughs, appointed from a list submitted

 by the association to the President pro tempore of the

 Senate.
- (vii) A representative of the Pennsylvania League of
 Cities and Municipalities, appointed from a list
 submitted by the league to the President pro tempore of
 the Senate.
- 16 (viii) A representative of the Pennsylvania

- 2 (3) Provide recommended measures that would ensure or 3 improve the fiscal stability of municipalities.
- 4 (4) Provide recommended changes that would make regional cooperation more attractive to municipalities.
