A RESOLUTION

- Designating September 17 through 23, 2009, as "Constitution Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, September 17, 2009, marks the 222nd anniversary of
- 4 the drafting of the Constitution of the United States of America
- 5 by the Constitutional Convention; and
- 6 WHEREAS, It is fitting and proper to accord official
- 7 recognition to this magnificent document and its memorable
- 8 anniversary and to the patriotic celebrations which will
- 9 commemorate the occasion; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Public Law 915 guarantees the issuing of a
- 11 proclamation each year by the President of the United States of
- 12 America designating September 17 through 23 as "Constitution

- 1 Week"; therefore be it
- 2 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate
- 3 September 17 through 23, 2009, as "Constitution Week" in
- 4 Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 5 RESOLVED, That all Pennsylvanians be encouraged to recognize
- 6 this historic observance.
