A RESOLUTION

- 1 Designating the month of September 2009 as "Alcohol and Drug
- Addiction Recovery Month" in Pennsylvania, and recognizing
- 3 the 20th anniversary of "National Alcohol and Drug Addiction
- 4 Recovery Month."
- 5 WHEREAS, Addiction to alcohol and other drugs is a public
- 6 health problem in this Commonwealth and across the United
- 7 States; and
- 8 WHEREAS, One in ten Pennsylvanians suffers from addiction;
- 9 and
- 10 WHEREAS, One in four families has a member with an alcohol or
- 11 other drug addiction; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Addiction treatment can be highly effective for
- 13 youths and adults; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Addiction treatment prevents fetal alcohol syndrome
- 2 and other addiction-related health conditions; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Addiction treatment reduces crime and driving under
- 4 the influence incidents while improving safety in communities,
- 5 neighborhoods, schools and healing devastated families; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Studies have demonstrated repeatedly that addiction
- 7 treatment saves approximately \$7 for every \$1 invested; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The House of Representatives recognizes the families
- 9 of persons who have lost their battle with addiction; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Alcoholics Anonymous, Narcotics Anonymous, groups
- 11 for families and addiction treatment centers across this
- 12 Commonwealth have shown leadership in providing resources for
- 13 persons suffering from alcohol and drug addiction; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Throughout the country, the month of September of
- 15 each year since 1989 has been observed as "National Alcohol and
- 16 Drug Addiction Recovery Month"; and
- 17 WHEREAS, The annual observance focuses on recovery and
- 18 treatment and allows individuals, families and communities in
- 19 this Commonwealth to recognize the benefits of addiction
- 20 treatment services as the way to end the downward spiral caused
- 21 by addiction; and
- 22 WHEREAS, In this, the 20th anniversary year of the initial
- 23 "National Alcohol and Drug Addition Recovery Month," the theme
- 24 is "Join the Voices for Recovery: Together We Learn, Together We
- 25 Heal," emphasizing the use of all available resources to achieve
- 26 recovery; therefore be it
- 27 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 28 month of September 2009 as "Alcohol and Drug Addiction Recovery
- 29 Month" in Pennsylvania and recognize the 20th anniversary of
- 30 "National Alcohol and Drug Addiction Recovery Month."
