A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the League of Women Voters of Pennsylvania on the
2 occasion of the 90th anniversary of its founding.

3 WHEREAS, The League of Women Voters of Pennsylvania is the
4 organization where hands-on work to safeguard democracy leads to
5 civic improvement; and

6 WHEREAS, The League of Women Voters of Pennsylvania is a
7 nonpartisan political organization that has fought since 1920 to
8 improve our system of government and impact public policies
9 through citizen education and advocacy; and

1 WHEREAS, The league members are constantly striving to serve
2 their communities to make strong, safe, fair and vibrant places
3 to live; and

4 WHEREAS, The League of Women Voters of Pennsylvania believes
5 in representative government and in the individual liberties
6 established in the Constitution of the United States; and

7 WHEREAS, The League of Women Voters of Pennsylvania has
8 always worked to promote the values and processes of
9 representative government; and

10 WHEREAS, The League of Women Voters of Pennsylvania
11 collaborates with other organizations to achieve mutual goals,
12 increase civic participation, create lasting change in the
13 community and to make democracy work; and

14 WHEREAS, The league, for 90 years, has held the public trust
15 by respectfully bringing elected leaders and the public together
16 through nonpartisan, civil means and through thoughtfully
17 advancing solutions; and

18 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth has benefited tremendously from
19 the countless volunteer hours donated by league members over its
20 90-year history of enhancing our democracy; therefore be it

21 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate
22 February 14, 2010, as "The League of Women Voters of
23 Pennsylvania Making Democracy Work Day" in honor of the League
24 of Women Voters' 90th anniversary and urge all residents of
25 Pennsylvania to pay great tribute and respect to The League of
26 Women Voters of Pennsylvania for all they do to make our
27 community healthy, vibrant and strong.
