A RESOLUTION

1 Designating June 6, 2010, as "Veterans Appreciation Day" in
2 Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, Men and women from Bradford County and throughout
4 this Commonwealth have faithfully served in the armed forces of
5 the United States; and

6 WHEREAS, Throughout this nation's history, from the
7 Revolutionary War to our presence in Iraq and other areas of the
8 world, men and women of Bradford County and the other counties
9 of this Commonwealth have answered the call to defend our
10 freedom, our liberties and our ideals; and

11 WHEREAS, Throughout the history of Bradford County and this
12 entire Commonwealth, many of these men and women have paid the
13 supreme sacrifice by giving their lives or their freedom to
14 perpetuate the unique concept of life, liberty and pursuit of
15 happiness upon which this great nation was founded; and

1 WHEREAS, Each year, for the 22nd consecutive year, a picnic
2 is held in honor of all veterans; and

3 WHEREAS, This year a picnic will be held on June 6, 2010, in
4 their honor to show appreciation to all veterans for their
5 sacrifices to allow the American people the freedoms they enjoy
6 every day; and

7 WHEREAS, The picnic will be held at Hornbrook Park in
8 Towanda, Bradford County; and

9 WHEREAS, June 6, 2010, marks the 66th anniversary of D-Day,
10 which is the theme for this year's event; and

11 WHEREAS, Residents of Bradford County and all of the other
12 counties of this Commonwealth once again gather to recognize
13 these men and women who have served with honor; therefore be it

14 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate June 6,
15 2010, as "Veterans Appreciation Day" in Pennsylvania; and be it

17 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives encourage all
18 citizens of this Commonwealth to take part in honoring the men
19 and women who have served our nation.
