A RESOLUTION

- 1 Designating the third week of October as "Male Breast Cancer
- 2 Awareness Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Each year, 450 men will die from male breast cancer
- 4 and the numbers are increasing; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Men are typically diagnosed at a late stage due to a
- 6 lack of awareness that men can develop the disease; and
- WHEREAS, It behooves each of us, men, women, parents,
- 8 siblings, educators and physicians, to promote awareness of the
- 9 disease and to save lives; and
- 10 WHEREAS, We must educate the world to the reality of this
- 11 disease; and
- 12 WHEREAS, In remembrance of the many men who have lost their
- 13 lives or are fighting for their lives, due to a lack of
- 14 awareness, it is appropriate that we designate the third week of
- 15 October as "Male Breast Cancer Awareness Week"; therefore be it
- 16 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 17 third week of October as "Male Breast Cancer Awareness Week" in
- 18 Pennsylvania.
