- 3 FIRE COMPANY OR OTHER ORGANIZATION for the costs of cleaning up
- 4 the environmental hazards associated with the operation of the
- 5 <u>laboratory or the use of a precursor substance to manufacture</u>
- 6 <u>methamphetamine</u>.
- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
