## AN ACT

1 Amending the act of April 14, 1972 (P.L.233, No.64), entitled  
2 "An act relating to the manufacture, sale and possession of  
3 controlled substances, other drugs, devices and cosmetics;  
4 conferring powers on the courts and the secretary and  
5 Department of Health, and a newly created Pennsylvania Drug,  
6 Device and Cosmetic Board; establishing schedules of  
7 controlled substances; providing penalties; requiring  
8 registration of persons engaged in the drug trade and for the  
9 revocation or suspension of certain licenses and  
10 registrations; and repealing an act," providing for  
11 environmental costs.

12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
13 hereby enacts as follows:

14 Section 1. The act of April 14, 1972 (P.L.233, No.64), known  
15 as The Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act, is  
16 amended by adding a section to read:

17 Section 13.3. Environmental Costs.--~~AIN ADDITION TO~~ ←  
18 RESTITUTION UNDER 18 PA.C.S. § 1110 (RELATING TO RESTITUTION FOR  
19 CLEANUP OF CLANDESTINE LABORATORIES), A person who is convicted  
20 of an offense involving the operation of a methamphetamine  
21 laboratory or the use of a precursor substance to manufacture

1 methamphetamine shall be ordered to reimburse the appropriate  
2 law enforcement agency, EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES ORGANIZATION, ←  
3 FIRE COMPANY OR OTHER ORGANIZATION for the costs of cleaning up  
4 the environmental hazards associated with the operation of the  
5 laboratory or the use of a precursor substance to manufacture  
6 methamphetamine.

7       Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
