## AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An

10	Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known

13	Section 1377.2. Teacher Certifications EMERGENCY PERMITS at
14	Approved Private Schools and Chartered Schools for the Deaf and
15	Blind Approved private schools and chartered schools for the
16	deaf and blind shall have the authority to apply for teacher
17	certifications EMERGENCY PERMITS through the Department of
18	Education pursuant to the criteria for eligibility established
1 9	under 22 Pa Code § 49 31 (relating to criteria for eligibility)

- 1 as if the teachers were employed by a public school entity
- 2 provided that all other conditions for obtaining an emergency
- 3 permit are met.
- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
