AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," further providing for manner of election or approval.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Section 1073(b) of the act of March 10, 1949
- 10 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949,
- 11 amended January 16, 1974 (P.L.1, No.1), is amended and the
- 12 section is amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 13 Section 1073. Manner of Election or Approval. -- * *
- 14 (b) [At] Except as provided in subsection (b.1), at a
- 15 regular meeting of the board of school directors occurring at
- 16 least one hundred fifty (150) days prior to the expiration date
- 17 of the term of office of the district superintendent, the agenda
- 18 shall include an item requiring affirmative action by five or
- 19 more members of the board of school directors to notify the
- 20 district superintendent that the board intends to retain him for

- 1 a further term of from three (3) to five (5) years or that
- 2 another or other candidates will be considered for the office.
- 3 In the event that the board fails to take such action at a
- 4 regular meeting of the board of school directors occurring at
- 5 least one hundred fifty (150) days prior to the expiration date
- 6 of the term of office of the district superintendent, he shall
- 7 continue in office for a further term of similar length to that
- 8 which he is serving.
- 9 (b.1) Notwithstanding subsection (b), where three or more
- 10 incumbent school directors have been defeated in the primary
- 11 <u>election and the contract of the district superintendent has</u>
- 12 <u>eleven (11) or more months remaining, the board shall be</u>
- 13 prohibited from taking any action on TO RENEW OR RESCIND, EXCEPT
- 14 FOR CAUSE, the district superintendent's contract until the new
- 15 board of school directors has taken office.

- 17 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
