AN ACT

- Designating the bridge THAT CARRIES STATE ROUTE 601 OVER BARCLAY RUN in the Borough of Somerset over Barclay Run, SOMERSET
- 3 COUNTY, as the Trooper Stephen R. Gyurke Memorial Bridge.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Trooper Stephen R. Gyurke Memorial Bridge.
- 7 (a) Declaration. -- The General Assembly declares that Trooper
- 8 Stephen R. Gyurke made the ultimate sacrifice for this
- 9 Commonwealth on August 24, 1958, when he died of injuries
- 10 suffered while performing his duties. Trooper Gyurke was
- 11 assigned to the Pennsylvania State Police Troop B-2 when on
- 12 August 21, 1958, he suffered severe injuries that would
- 13 eventually lead to his death during a traffic stop on the
- 14 Pennsylvania Turnpike in Westmoreland County.
- 15 (b) Designation. -- The bridge THAT CARRIES STATE ROUTE 601
- 16 over Barclay Run in the Borough of Somerset, SOMERSET COUNTY, is
- 17 designated as the Trooper Stephen R. Gyurke Memorial Bridge.
- 18 (c) Signs. -- The Department of Transportation shall place and

- 1 maintain appropriate signs at both ends of the bridge designated
- 2 in subsection (b).
- 3 Section 2. Effective date.
- 4 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
