- 15 usual signal for a pilot and continue to make such signal till
- 16 reaching Brandywine Light, and if spoken by, or offered the
- 17 services of, a duly licensed Pennsylvania pilot before reaching
- 18 Brandywine Light, shall be obliged to employ such pilot and pay
- 19 him for services rendered on and after the effective date of
- 20 this act, a charge computed as follows:
