15	[Section 1. The purpose of this act is to encourage owners
16	of land to make land and water areas available to the public for
17	recreational purposes by limiting their liability.]
18	Section 2. The act is amended by adding sections to read:
19	Section 1.1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
20	"Recreational Use of Land and Water Act."

1 Section 1.2. The purpose of this act is to encourage owners 2 of land to make land and water areas available to the public for 3 recreational purposes by limiting their liability. Section 3. Section 2 of the act, amended March 26, 1992 4 (P.L.27, No.10), is amended to read: 5 6 Section 2. [As used in this act:] The following words and 7 phrases when used in this act shall have the meanings given to 8 them in this section unless the context clearly indicates 9 otherwise: 10 "Charge." The admission price or fee asked in return for invitation or permission to enter or go upon the land. 11 [(1) "Land" means land] <u>"Land." Land</u>, roads, water, 12 13 watercourses, private ways and buildings, structures and machinery or equipment when attached to the realty. The term 14 includes nature trails. 15 [(2) "Owner" means the] <u>"Owner." The</u> possessor of a fee 16 interest, a tenant, lessee, occupant or person in control of the 17 18 premises. 19 [(3) "Recreational purpose" includes] <u>"Recreational</u> purpose." The term includes, but is not limited to, any of the 20 following, or any combination thereof: hunting, fishing, 21 swimming, boating, camping, picnicking, hiking, pleasure 22 23 driving, nature study, water skiing, water sports, cave 24 exploration and viewing or enjoying historical, archaeological, 25 scenic, or scientific sites, and walking, jogging, bicycling, exercising and horseback riding on nature trails. 26 [(4) "Charge" means the admission price or fee asked in 27 28 return for invitation or permission to enter or go upon the 29 land.] 30 Section 4. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
