A RESOLUTION

2 as "Probation, Parole and Community Supervision Week" in

5 criminal justice system; and

7 with dignity, while recognizing the right of the public to be
8 safe-guarded from criminal activity; and

10 for supervising adult and juvenile offenders in the community;

13 professionals who provide services and referrals for offenders;

17 WHEREAS, Community corrections professionals promote

1 prevention, intervention and advocacy; and

2 WHEREAS, Community corrections professionals provide
3 services, support and protection for victims; and

4 WHEREAS, Community corrections professionals advocate
5 community and restorative justice; therefore be it
