A RESOLUTION
Extending a warm welcome to the United States Women's Open golf tournament to be hosted by the Saucon Valley Country Club in Bethlehem on July 6 through 12, 2009.

WHEREAS, The Saucon Valley Country Club was founded in 1920 and is one of the largest private country clubs in North America, comprising three 18-hole golf courses and a six-hole short course on its 800 acres in the Lehigh Valley; and WHEREAS, As it has five times previously, Saucon Valley Country Club will host a United States Golf Association event on July 6 through 12, 2009, when it hosts the United States Women's Open golf tournament; and

WHEREAS, Hosting a U.S. Women's Open involves approximately 2,500 volunteers, along with the cooperation of numerous State and municipal officials and law enforcement agencies; and WHEREAS, The event will have an estimated $\$ 25$ million impact on the local economy and will draw national television coverage; and

WHEREAS, International exposure from the event is likely as
