AN ACT

Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the 1 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in registration of sexual 3 offenders, further providing for information made available 4 on the Internet. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Section 9798.1(a) and (b) introductory paragraph 8 of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are 9 amended and subsection (b) is amended by adding a paragraph to 10 read: § 9798.1. Information made available on the Internet and 11 12 electronic notification. 13 Legislative findings.--It is hereby declared to be the (a) finding of the General Assembly that public safety will be 14 15 enhanced by making information about sexually violent predators,

lifetime registrants and other sex offenders available to the 1 2 public through the Internet and electronic notification. 3 Knowledge of whether a person is a sexually violent predator, lifetime registrant or other sex offender could be a significant 4 factor in protecting oneself and one's family members, or those 5 in care of a group or community organization, from recidivist 6 acts by sexually violent predators, lifetime registrants and 7 8 other sex offenders. The technology afforded by the Internet and electronic notification would make this information readily 9 accessible to parents and private entities, enabling them to 10 undertake appropriate remedial precautions to prevent or avoid 11 12 placing potential victims at risk. Public access to information 13 about sexually violent predators, lifetime registrants and other 14 sex offenders is intended solely as a means of public protection 15 and shall not be construed as punitive.

16 (b) Internet posting of sexually violent predators, lifetime 17 registrants [and], other offenders <u>and electronic</u>

18 <u>notification</u>.--The Commissioner of the Pennsylvania State Police 19 shall, in the manner and form directed by the Governor:

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21 <u>(7) Notwithstanding 18 Pa.C.S. Ch. 91 (relating to</u> 22 criminal history record information), develop, implement and 23 maintain a process which allows members of the public to 24 receive electronic notification when an individual required 25 to register under this subchapter moves into or out of a 26 user-designated location.

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28 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

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
