11 § 3742. Accidents involving death or personal injury.

13 (b) Penalties.--

2 (3) If the victim dies, any person violating subsection  
3 (a) commits a felony of the third degree, and the sentencing  
4 court shall order the person to serve a minimum term of  
5 imprisonment of not less than [one year] three years and a  
6 mandatory minimum fine of \$2,500, notwithstanding any other  
7 provision of law.

9 § 6503. SUBSEQUENT CONVICTIONS OF CERTAIN OFFENSES. ←

10 (A) GENERAL OFFENSES.--EVERY PERSON CONVICTED OF A SECOND OR  
11 SUBSEQUENT VIOLATION OF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING PROVISIONS SHALL BE  
12 SENTENCED TO PAY A FINE OF NOT LESS THAN \$200 NOR MORE THAN  
13 \$1,000 OR TO IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN SIX MONTHS, OR BOTH:

14 SECTION 1543(A) (RELATING TO DRIVING WHILE OPERATING  
15 PRIVILEGE IS SUSPENDED OR REVOKED) EXCEPT AS SET FORTH IN  
16 SUBSECTION (A.1).

17 SECTION 3367 (RELATING TO RACING ON HIGHWAYS).

18 [SECTION 3733 (RELATING TO FLEEING OR ATTEMPTING TO ELUDE  
19 POLICE OFFICER).]

20 SECTION 3734 (RELATING TO DRIVING WITHOUT LIGHTS TO AVOID  
21 IDENTIFICATION OR ARREST).
