1 Amending the act of December 4, 1996 (P.L.911, No.147), entitled
2 "An act providing for registration requirements for
3 telemarketers and for powers and duties of the Office of
4 Attorney General," further providing FOR UNLAWFUL ACTS AND ←
5 PENALTIES AND for unwanted telephone solicitation calls
6 prohibited.

7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8 hereby enacts as follows:

12 SECTION 1. SECTION 5(A) OF THE ACT OF DECEMBER 4, 1996 ←
13 (P.L.911, NO.147), KNOWN AS THE TELEMARKETER REGISTRATION ACT,
14 IS AMENDED BY ADDING A PARAGRAPH TO READ:

1 SECTION 5. UNLAWFUL ACTS AND PENALTIES.

2 (A) ACTS ENUMERATED.--THE FOLLOWING ACTS ARE PROHIBITED:

4 (10) CONDUCTING TELEMARKETING ON A LEGAL HOLIDAY.

6 SECTION 2. SECTION 5.2(C) OF THE ACT, AMENDED SEPTEMBER 12,
7 2003 (P.L.105, NO.22), IS AMENDED TO READ:

8 Section 5.2. Unwanted telephone solicitation calls prohibited.

10 (c) Duration.--A listing on a do-not-call list shall be
11 maintained [for a minimum of five years from the date of the
12 enrollment or] until the telephone number is no longer valid for
13 the residential or wireless telephone subscriber[, whichever
14 occurs first] or until the subscriber requests to have the
15 telephone number removed from the list.

17 Section ~~2~~ 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
