IF, AFTER JULY 31, 2003, TWO OR MORE VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANIES 17 18 CONSOLIDATE THEIR USE OF FACILITIES, EQUIPMENT, FIREFIGHTERS AND 19 SERVICES, THE CONSOLIDATED ENTITY MAY, UPON NOTIFICATION OF THE [AGENCY] COMMISSIONER, BE ELIGIBLE FOR A REDUCTION OF THE 20 INTEREST RATE PAYABLE ON ANY OUTSTANDING PRINCIPAL BALANCE OWED, 21 AS OF THE DATE OF CONSOLIDATION, BY ANY OR ALL OF THE 22 23 CONSOLIDATING COMPANIES TO THE VOLUNTEER COMPANIES LOAN FUND FOR 24 LOANS MADE UNDER THE ACT OF JULY 15, 1976 (P.L.1036, NO.208), 25 KNOWN AS THE VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY, AMBULANCE SERVICE AND 26 RESCUE SQUAD ASSISTANCE ACT, OR UNDER SUBCHAPTER E OF CHAPTER 73 27 (RELATING TO VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY, AMBULANCE SERVICE AND 28 RESCUE SQUAD ASSISTANCE).
