AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
- 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for
- qualifications of judicial officers generally.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 3101(a) of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 3101. Qualifications of judicial officers generally.
- 9 (a) General rule. -- Judges and magisterial district judges
- 10 shall be citizens of this Commonwealth. Judges, except judges of
- 11 the Pittsburgh Magistrates Court and the Traffic Court of
- 12 Philadelphia, shall be members of the bar of this Commonwealth.
- 13 Judges of the Supreme, Superior and Commonwealth Courts, for a
- 14 period of one year preceding their election or appointment and
- 15 during their continuance in office, shall reside within this
- 16 Commonwealth. Other judges and magisterial district judges, for
- 17 a period of one year preceding their election or appointment and

- 1 during their continuance in office, shall reside within their
- 2 respective districts, except when temporarily assigned to
- 3 another district pursuant to law. Judges and magisterial
- 4 district judges shall be at least [21] <u>25</u> years of age.
- 5 * * *
- 6 Section 2. The amendment of 42 Pa.C.S. § 3101(a) shall apply
- 7 to judges and magisterial district judges elected or appointed
- 8 on or after the effective date of this section.
- 9 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
