## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, prohibiting the retail sale and
- distribution of novelty lighters; and imposing a penalty.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 7332. Retail sale and distribution of novelty lighters
- 9 prohibited.
- 10 (a) Offense defined. -- It shall be unlawful for any person to
- 11 <u>sell at retail, offer for retail sale or distribute for retail</u>
- 12 <u>sale or promotion in this Commonwealth a novelty lighter.</u>
- 13 (b) Grading. -- A person who violates subsection (a) commits a
- 14 <u>summary offense</u>.
- 15 (c) Exception. -- Nothing contained in this section shall
- 16 prohibit the transportation of novelty lighters through this
- 17 Commonwealth or the storage of novelty lighters in a warehouse
- 18 or distribution center in this Commonwealth if the warehouse or

- 1 <u>distribution center is closed to the public for purposes of</u>
- 2 retail sales.
- 3 (d) Definition. -- As used in this section the term "novelty
- 4 <u>lighter" means a mechanical or electrical device typically used</u>
- 5 for lighting cigarettes, cigars or pipes that is designed to
- 6 appear to be a toy, to feature a flashing light or to make
- 7 <u>musical sounds. The term does not include:</u>
- 8 (1) A lighter manufactured prior to January 1, 1980.
- 9 (2) A lighter incapable of being fueled or lacking a
- device necessary to produce combustion or a flame.
- 11 (3) Any mechanical or electrical device primarily used
- 12 <u>to ignite fuel for fireplaces or for charcoal or gas grills.</u>
- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
