AN ACT

1 Amending Title 24 (Education) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, in retirement, further providing for limited early
3 retirement.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 8313 of Title 24 of the Pennsylvania
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 8313. Eligibility for limited early retirement.

9 Notwithstanding any provisions of this title to the contrary,
10 the following early retirement provisions shall be applicable to
11 eligible members:

12 (1) Any member who, during the period of time from the
13 effective date of this section through July 10, 1998:

14 (i) has credit for at least 30 eligibility points;

15 (ii) terminates school service; and

16 (iii) files an application for an annuity with an
17 effective date of retirement not later than July 11,

1 1998,
2 shall be entitled to receive a maximum single life annuity
3 calculated pursuant to section 8342 (relating to maximum
4 single life annuity) without any reduction by virtue of an
5 effective date of retirement which is under the
6 superannuation age.

7 (2) Any member who, during the period of time from April
8 1, 1999, through June 30, 1999:

9 (i) has credit for at least 30 eligibility points;
10 (ii) terminates school service; and
11 (iii) files an application for an annuity with an
12 effective date of retirement not later than July 1, 1999,
13 shall be entitled to receive a maximum single life annuity
14 calculated pursuant to section 8342 without any reduction by
15 virtue of an effective date of retirement which is under the
16 superannuation age.

17 (3) Any member who, during the period of time from March
18 1, 2012, through June 30, 2012:

19 (i) Has attained at least 30 eligibility points.
20 (ii) Sends notice of intent to terminate school
21 service to a superintendent of the retiring employee's
22 school district between March 1 and June 30, 2012.
23 (iii) Terminates school service.
24 (iv) Files an application for an annuity with an
25 effective date of retirement not later than July 1, 2012
26 shall be entitled to receive a maximum single life annuity
27 calculated pursuant to section 8342 without any reduction by
28 virtue of an effective date of retirement which is under the
29 superannuation age.

30 (4) Any member who, during the period of time from March

1 1, 2013, through June 30, 2013:

2 (i) Has credit for at least 30 eligibility points.

3 (ii) Sends notice of intent to terminate school
4 service to a superintendent of the retiring employee's
5 school district between March 1 and June 30, 2013.

6 (iii) Terminates school service.

7 (iv) Files an application for an annuity with an
8 effective date of retirement not later than July 1, 2013
9 shall be entitled to receive a maximum single life annuity
10 calculated pursuant to section 8342 without any reduction by
11 virtue of an effective date of retirement which is under the
12 superannuation age.

13 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
