AN ACT

1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania  
2 Consolidated Statutes, providing for the offense of sexual  
3 assault by sports official.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

8 § 3124.3. Sexual assault by sports official.

9 (a) General rule.--Except as provided in section 3121  
10 (relating to rape), 3122.1 (relating to statutory sexual  
11 assault), 3123 (relating to involuntary deviate sexual  
12 intercourse), 3124.1 (relating to sexual assault) and 3125  
13 (relating to aggravated indecent assault), a person who serves  
14 as a sports official in a sports program of a nonprofit  
15 association or a for-profit association commits a felony of the  
16 third degree when that person engages in sexual intercourse,  
17 deviate sexual intercourse or indecent contact with a child

1 under 18 years of age who is participating in a sports program  
2 of the nonprofit association or for-profit association.

3 (b) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following  
4 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this  
5 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:

6 "Nonprofit association." As defined in 42 Pa.C.S. § 8332.1  
7 (relating to manager, coach, umpire or referee and nonprofit  
8 association negligence standard).

9 "Sports official." A person who supervises children  
10 participating in a sports program of a nonprofit association or  
11 a for-profit association, including, but not limited to, a  
12 coach, assistant coach, athletic trainer, team attendant, game  
13 manager, instructor or a person at a sports program who enforces  
14 the rules of a sporting event sponsored by a sports program of a  
15 nonprofit association or a for-profit association, including,  
16 but not limited to, an umpire or referee, whether receiving  
17 remuneration or holding the position as a volunteer.

18 "Sports program." As defined in 42 Pa.C.S. § 8332.1  
19 (relating to manager, coach, umpire or referee and nonprofit  
20 association negligence standard).

21 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
