AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, in general provisions, further defining
3 "motorcycle."

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. The definition of "motorcycle" in section 102 of
7 Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to
8 read:

9 § 102. Definitions.

10 Subject to additional definitions contained in subsequent
11 provisions of this title which are applicable to specific
12 provisions of this title, the following words and phrases when

1 used in this title shall have, unless the context clearly
2 indicates otherwise, the meanings given to them in this section:

3 * * *

4 "Motorcycle." A motor vehicle having a seat or saddle for
5 the use of the rider and:

6 (1) designed to travel on not more than three wheels in
7 contact with the ground; or

8 (2) designed to travel on two wheels in contact with the
9 ground which is modified by the addition of two stabilizing
10 wheels on the rear of the motor vehicle.

12 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
