## AN ACT

- Requiring the Department of Environmental Protection to submit annual reports relating to certain restricted accounts in the
- 3 State Treasury.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Short title.
- 7 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Department of
- 8 Environmental Protection Restricted Account Reporting Act.
- 9 Section 2. Definitions.
- 10 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 11 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 12 context clearly indicates otherwise:

- 1 "Department." The Department of Environmental Protection of
- 2 the Commonwealth.
- 3 "Restricted accounts." The following funds within the State
- 4 Treasury:
- 5 (1) The Clean Water Fund established under the act of
- 6 June 22, 1937 (P.L.1987, No.394), known as The Clean Streams
- 7 Law.
- 8 (2) The Solid Waste Abatement Fund established under the
- 9 act of July 7, 1980 (P.L.380, No.97), known as the Solid
- Waste Management Act.
- 11 (3) The Clean Air Fund established under the act of
- 12 January 8, 1960 (1959 P.L.2119, No.787), known as the Air
- 13 Pollution Control Act.
- 14 Section 3. Duty to submit annual report.
- No later than July 1, 2012, and every July 1 thereafter, the
- 16 department shall submit to the Governor and the General Assembly
- 17 an annual report of the revenues received and projects funded
- 18 resulting from fines, civil penalties and other fees deposited
- 19 into the restricted accounts.
- 20 Section 4. Contents of annual report.
- 21 (a) General rule. -- The annual report required by section 3
- 22 shall include the following information for each restricted
- 23 account:
- 24 (1) The amount of fines, civil penalties and fees
- deposited into the restricted account.
- 26 (2) A listing of all grants, loans and other expenses
- 27 paid from the restricted account, including the name of each
- grant recipient, location and description of the project
- 29 financed by the grant, the amount of funds from all sources
- 30 allocated to the project and the expiration date of the

- 1 project.
- 2 (b) Publication. -- The department shall publish and maintain
- 3 the annual report on the department's publicly accessible
- 4 Internet website.
- 5 (c) Electronic submission. -- At the discretion of the
- 6 department, the annual report required under section 3 may be
- 7 submitted to the Governor and the General Assembly by electronic
- 8 mail.
- 9 Section 5. Effective date.
- 10 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
