## AN ACT

- Amending the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103, No.69), entitled, as reenacted and amended, "An act concerning townships of the second class; and amending, revising, consolidating and
- changing the law relating thereto," repealing provisions
- 5 relating to removal of township officer for failure to
- 6 perform duties.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Section 503 of the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103,
- 10 No.69), known as The Second Class Township Code, reenacted and
- 11 amended November 9, 1995 (P.L.350, No.60), is repealed:
- 12 [Section 503. Removal for Failure to Perform Duties.--If any
- 13 township officer fails to perform the duties of the office, the
- 14 court of common pleas upon complaint in writing by five percent
- 15 of the electors of the township may issue a rule upon the
- 16 officer to show cause why the office should not be declared
- 17 vacant. The officer shall respond to the rule within thirty days
- 18 from its date of issue. Upon hearing, the court may declare the
- 19 office vacant and require the vacancy to be filled under section
- 20 407.1

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
