1 2 3	Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for nonreciprocity of operational limitations.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 6154 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
8	§ 6154. Nonreciprocity of operational limitations.
9	(a) General ruleIf any other state with which the
10	department has entered into a reciprocity agreement, including
11	the International Registration Plan, imposes an operational
12	limitation, burden or prohibition upon vehicles with a base
13	jurisdiction of Pennsylvania but not upon vehicles with a base
14	jurisdiction of the other state, the Commonwealth shall impose a
15	like operational limitation, burden or prohibition upon the same
16	class of vehicles that are operating in this Commonwealth but
17	based in the other state. Operational limitations shall include

- 1 the maximum weight, width, length or height of a vehicle.
- 2 <u>(b)</u> Penalty.--A person who violates this section commits a
- 3 summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay
- 4 a fine of not less than \$500 and not more than \$1,000 for each
- 5 <u>violation.</u>
- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
