Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for 2 powers and duties of the Juvenile Court Judges' Commission. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 6373(4) of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: § 6373. Powers and duties. 8 9 The commission shall have the power and is required to do the 10 following: 11 12 (4) Collect[, compile and publish such] and analyze 13 statistical trends, evidence based programs and practices and 14 other data as may be [needed to accomplish] necessary to 15 ensure reasonable and efficient administration of the 16 juvenile [courts] court system, to make recommendations to

- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
