- Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for retail theft.

- 5 Section 1. Section 3929(f) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
- 6 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a definition to read:
- 7 § 3929. Retail theft.

- 11 "First offense." Any conviction, acceptance of Accelerated
- 12 Rehabilitative Disposition or other form of preliminary
- 13 <u>disposition before the sentencing on the present violation for</u>
- 14 <u>an offense under this section or an offense substantially</u>
- 15 similar to an offense under this section.

- 1 Section 2. The amendment of 18 Pa.C.S. § 3929(f) shall apply
- 2 to sentences imposed on or after the effective date of this
- 3 section.
- 4 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
