10	(a.1) Assault of law enforcement officer in the second
11	degreeA person commits a felony of the second degree if he
12	intentionally or knowingly causes or attempts to cause a law
13	enforcement officer, while in the performance of his duty, to
14	come into contact with blood, seminal fluid, saliva, urine or
15	feces by throwing, tossing, spitting or expelling such fluid or

1	reason to know, should have known or believed such fluid or
2	material to have been obtained from an individual, including the
3	person charged under this subsection, infected by a communicable_
4	disease, including, but not limited to, human immunodeficiency
5	<u>virus (HIV) or hepatitis B.</u>

7	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
