## AN ACT

- Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in assault, further providing for the offense of aggravated assault. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Aggravated assault. 10 Offense defined. -- A person is guilty of aggravated 11 assault if he: 12
