AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, providing for special plates for individuals in the
3 service of the United States Merchant Marine.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

8 § 1357.1. Special plates for individuals in the service of the
9 United States Merchant Marine.

10 Upon application of any person who was in the service of the
11 United States Merchant Marine during World War II, accompanied
12 by a fee of \$20, which shall be in addition to the annual
13 registration fee, and by such documentation as the department
14 shall require, the department shall issue to the person a
15 special registration plate designating the vehicle so licensed

1 as belonging to a person who was in the service of the United
2 States Merchant Marine during World War II. The special
3 registration plate may be used only on a passenger car or truck
4 with a registered gross weight of not more than 14,000 pounds.

5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
