AN ACT

- Designating the bridge that carries State Route 462 over the Norfolk Southern rail line in the Borough of Mountville,
- 3 Lancaster County, as the Mountville Veterans Memorial Bridge.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Mountville Veterans Memorial Bridge.
- 7 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (1) Originally built in 1931, the bridge carrying State
- 10 Route 462 over the Norfolk Southern rail line in the Borough
- of Mountville, Lancaster County, is being reconstructed.
- 12 (2) The Mountville Borough Council adopted a resolution
- on August 8, 2011, requesting that the Department of
- 14 Transportation name the newly constructed bridge in honor of
- 15 the borough's military veterans, who have valiantly served
- and defended the United States over the years.

- 1 (3) The council's resolution requests that the new
- 2 bridge bear the designation Mountville Veterans Memorial
- 3 Bridge.
- 4 (b) Designation. -- The bridge that carries State Route 462
- 5 over the Norfolk Southern rail line in the Borough of
- 6 Mountville, Lancaster County, is designated as the Mountville
- 7 Veterans Memorial Bridge.
- 8 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 9 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
- 10 traffic in both directions.
- 11 Section 2. Effective date.
- 12 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
